- NCR - Steve Gallagher and Aariah Fine
 - *Intro*
 - *Goal is be here for questions, technical support*
 - *NCR is a funder for the neighborhood orgs*
 - *Aariah's works with 34 neighborhoods*
 - *Team of 4 at NCR working as a support role to neighborhood orgs.*
 - *Understanding funding*
 - *Old money (NRP) - there for you to use, will not expire. When it runs out it is gone. To move this money around there is a process to follow.*
 - *New money (NCR) - current operating funds. We are expected to use it each year. We are expected to spend this and not stockpile it.*
 - *Opened it for questions*
 - *Alexander: There is a calendar invite to a citywide meeting, also info on upcoming applications. Can we all get on this invite? Aariah: will send invite*
 - *Alexander: There was a citywide pilot program on snow removal. As an example - what sorts of communication exist between NCR and other city programs? Aariah: A lot of their role is this coordination*

- Martha: confirmed we have a handle on the deadlines
 - Alexander: Is neighborhoods 2020 expected to be indefinite? Ariaiah: tending to last every 10 years. We can expect in 2030ish they will re-look at the program, but don't expect a larger change. The only thing that Ariaiah expects would change would be tweaks to the program and what they are prioritizing. The funding for neighborhood orgs comes out of general fund - a little more vulnerable to budget adjustments, but likely pretty safe.
 - Dana: Unidos approached us wanting to do a training on ICE bystander training. Can we do this in a non-partisan way? Ariaiah: Knowing your rights is a non-partisan thing. Further clarification - NCR can provide guidance on how to use City dollars. There is a separate piece that is maintaining non-profit status.
- Ella Baker Inclusive Playground project - Molly Dengler and Sarah Cooper-Evans
 - Goal of presentation: summarize the work over the last year
 - Students have emailed every donor as a thank you
 - Project guided by types of service (research, direct service, indirect service, advocacy) - educational focus at Ella Baker
 - Fundraising
 - Bake sale, penny wars, basketball game, ella baker eagle
 - Two thermometers to track fundraising progress
 - Collaboration with other student groups, visit to school district
 - Part of the PEF is to host people at Ella Baker to learn more
 - Thinking of hosting engagement on election day
 - Pete: would defer to Minneapolis elections for most updated rules on what you can do at an election site
 - What's next for fundraisers: open streets, lemonade, chores?
 - Alexander: Suggest Uptown Farmers Market
 - Kids are going to have an elective class
 - Big chunk of the funding is going to a coordinator
 - Playground is going to be built next summer (phase 1), but the rest of the space will happen in phase 2 (designed with student engagement)
 - The vision is that the art and garden would be together with LHENA - neighbors would take part in some of the making of the space
 - Part of the PEF fund - videos on inclusive playground
 - Final design - voted on June 10
 - Question for the group: money from fundraisers, should someone from LHENA be on the contract with LHENA and the City (Elise can sign)
- Updated Bylaws Conversation- Pete
 - Pete re-confirmed with Steve Gallagher that any paid position will be subject to what is in the executive director section of bylaws
 - Pete confirmed that what was in our bylaws was what NCR recommended
 - Need to have 6 positions up for election every year - need 3 newly elected board members to serve a 1 year term
- Open Streets- Elise
 - Participation?
- Update on Community Solar Project- Elise
 - No updates yet from Keiko
- Update on Staffing/LHENA Structure- Elise
 - Jack resignation

- Unidos Rapid Response training- *Dana?*
 - Training inform bystanders/English-speaking citizens what they can and should do if they see an ICE raid in their neighborhood or workplace. The goal is to get as many people across the state trained, so that when there is an ICE raid, we have a hotline that alerts people in the area who can respond.
 - *LHENA is not currently committed to providing funding*
 - *LVN is not taking on the project unless there is a lead for it*
 - *Martha and Alexander will work on it*
 - *Queermunity and Springhouse Ministries could work*
