As a 501(c)3 nonprofit dedicated to the public good, Lowry Hill East Neighborhood Association (LHENA) considers your privacy a top priority. This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, and disclose your information when you do any of the following:

- Visit our website
- Subscribe to one of our mailing lists
- Correspond with us via email
- Attend one of our events
- Volunteer for a LHENA project
- Donate to us

LHENA maintains reasonable physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to keep the data we collect about you safe.

Our website includes links to third-party websites that are not affiliated with us. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of these third-party websites. Any use of these external links is solely at your own risk.

What information we collect

Below are the types of data we may collect about you when you interact with us:

Device identifiers, IP address, and usage

When you visit thewedge.org or click links in our emails, we may log information about your device, IP address, and the pages you visit. We use this information to measure engagement and make improvements to the website.

Name and contact details

We may collect your name, mailing address, email address, and phone number when you voluntarily provide it to us. We use this information to contact you, send you LHENA-related materials, analyze the reach of our projects, or for other purposes you have requested.

Billing details

When you donate money to us, we collect card or bank details so we can collect your donation.

Email correspondence

If you choose to send LHENA an email, we may retain your email address, the original email message, and any replies as part of our correspondence.

Attendance and participation

We track attendance and participation with LHENA-hosted events and projects to measure engagement and enhance our reach.

How we share your data

We do not sell your data or personal information. Below are the third parties with whom we may share your data:

Service providers, contractors, and vendors

We use third parties to assist with administration, marketing, data storage, and other services that help us carry out neighborhood projects. These parties are not allowed to use your data for purposes other than those delegated to them.

Employees and trusted volunteers

We give a small selection of LHENA employees and trusted volunteers limited access to your data to carry out neighborhood projects and other purposes mentioned in this Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement agencies

In the event we receive a valid law enforcement request or court order, we may be legally compelled to share information about you.

From time to time, we may also share or publish data in an aggregated, de-identified form.

Your choices

Our website uses "cookies" to help us provide better services. Cookies allow our website to recognize you and your preferences for our website based on your previous browsing habits on our website. Cookies are files that are maintained on your computer and are read when you visit our website. You may limit or reject the use of cookies on our website using your browser's cookie settings.
